7 SIMPLE TOOLS – CAUSE AND EFFECT DIAGRAMS

The cause and effect diagram is a brainstorming and communication tool. It organizes potential input variables (causes) that could impact the output (effect). <http://bit.ly/1qpBaYC> We tend to talk about it as the 6 Ms. They are Measures, Machine, Methods, Manpower, Materials and Mother nature. These are the core “bones” on what is sometimes called a “fishbone” diagram and then they can split from there to include more details. When a project identifies only 2-3 potential variables, this is a great approach to uncover more possibilities in a short period of time.
